

Children who were born between **1 July 2017** and **30 June 2018** are eligible to attend Kindergarten at Brookton District High School in the **2022** school year.

Parents will need to collect an information pack from the school Administration Office. Once completed, please return the *Application for Enrolment*, a copy of your child's **Birth Certificate** and an **AIR Immunisation History Statement** to submit the application. Full enrolment packages will be given to parents at the Kindergarten Information Morning held in Term 4.

Parents are encouraged to submit their application before the end of this term, as applications closed on **Friday 23th July, 2021**.

For those students that may require Bus Transport, we strongly encourage you apply online at www.schoolbuses.wa.gov.au as soon as possible so that your place on the bus is ready for the commencement of the new school year.


