#### 2023 Voluntary Contributions, Charges and Fees

Voluntary Contributions, Charges and Fees have been adopted as per the Department of Education Policy.

2023 Schedules have now been approved by the Finance Committee and endorsed by the School Board.

#### Kindy - \$40.00 (\$10.00 per term) Pre-Primary to Year 6 Contributions - \$60.00 - (\$15.00 per term) Secondary Contributions (Years 7 to 10) - \$235.00 - (\$58.75 per term)

The Finance Committee and School Board have endorsed the schedules for these charges as required by the Financial Directorate. The payment of Voluntary Contributions impacts significantly on what we as a school can offer and provide for your child in addition to their core educational curriculum.

The school is required to fund core programs and curriculum related learning from the School Grant received each year. Payment and collection of voluntary contributions covers student incurred costs across each learning area and at each year level as per the 2023 schedule.

Parents are asked to consider these expenses when choosing to pay or not to pay this minimal amount for your child's educational journey.

#### Secondary Assistance Scheme (S.A.S.) & ABSTUDY
